

## COVID-19 Vaccine Frequently Asked Questions

### When Can I Get a COVID-19 Vaccine?\*

- The [Oregon Health Authority](#) will continue to communicate vaccine developments and distribution guidelines from the Centers of Disease Control (CDC) to prioritize vaccine administration for additional high-risk groups in subsequent vaccine phases. The OHA coronavirus vaccine website, at [covidvaccine.oregon.gov](https://covidvaccine.oregon.gov), is the best resource for information on the distribution phases.

### Where Can I Get a COVID-19 Vaccine?\*

- IHN-CCO members may receive their COVID-19 vaccination from any licensed Oregon Medicaid provider (including county health departments).
- Medicare beneficiaries can receive their COVID-19 vaccination from any Medicare provider even if the provider is out-of-network for their Medicare Advantage Plan.
- For all other members, they can receive their COVID-19 vaccination from any provider, even if the provider is out-of-network. Balance billing could apply to out-of-network providers.

### How Much Can I Expect to Pay for the COVID-19 Vaccine?\*

- For IHN-CCO members, in-network providers will bill the administrative cost of the vaccine to IHN-CCO and you will have no out-of-pocket costs.
- Medicare Advantage plan members can receive their COVID-19 vaccinations from any Medicare provider even if the provider is out-of-network for their Medicare Advantage Plan.
- All other members can receive their COVID-19 vaccination from any provider, even if the provider is out-of-network. Balance billing could apply for out-of-network providers.
